## The Route

**2** Take Church Road walking uphill towards Dundry.

Take the left fork that becomes Queens Road.

**3** At the crossroads turn up the driveway on your left opposite the Queens Head Pub.

**4** Continue across the carpark, through the blue gates by the church and turn right briefly on Gatehouse Avenue, then left at the end to local Queens Road shops.

**5** Finally turn right up Three Wells Road to Withywood Park.
